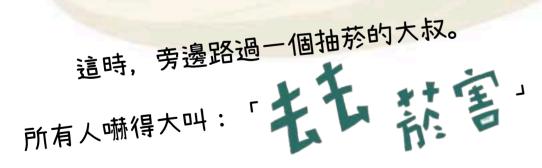

補充知識

P8

菸的有毒成分:

(1) 尼古丁:

是一種容易上癮的物質,會造成血壓升高、血管收縮、削弱免疫系統等。

(2) 焦油:

是一種焦黃色的黏性物質,令吸菸者手指 及牙齒變黃,還會累積在氣管及肺中導致 支氣管炎、肺癌、口腔癌。

(3) 一氧化碳:

會使血液減少 15% 的氧氣含量,使肺功能降低、血液循環受阻,造成體內缺氧。

(4) 有毒物及致癌物:

菸草中含有超過 7,000 種化學物質, 其中 250 種是有毒的, 至少有 93 種已知的致癌物。

避免星火燎原:

- (1) 請勿於室內抽菸, 吸菸時請遠離易燃物品。
- (2) 妥善處理菸蒂、菸灰, 確認火源已經熄滅。
- (3) 菸蒂、菸灰以適當容器收集, 並每天清理。
- (4) 請勸家人盡速戒菸。

吸菸對健康的危害:

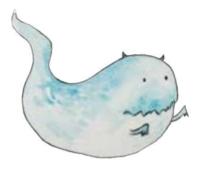
腔:會造成口臭、損害味蕾、牙齒泛黃、 蛀牙。

皮 膚:皮膚粗糙、容易罹患乾癬,全身癢 與紅斑。

指 甲:指甲易成黃褐色,手指變黃、有菸 味。

肺臟心臟:傷肺也傷心,導致咳嗽、氣喘、肺癌、 胸悶、心肌梗塞、心臟病。

視力惡化:吸菸會使眼睛疾病惡化,加重白內 障的機率並可能造成失明。

二手菸 (Second Hand Smoke)

是指被動或非自願吸入的環境菸。含超過 250 種有害物質,會加重幼兒氣喘、支氣管炎、肺癌、中耳炎等呼吸道疾病。

二手菸是室內霾害 (PM2.5) 的主要來源。吸菸者家中的細懸浮微粒 (PM2.5) 是非吸菸者家中的 10 倍。細懸浮微粒 (PM2.5) 是致癌物,與吸菸者同住得到肺癌的機率高出 20-30%。

三手菸(Third hand smoke)

指的是菸熄滅後在環境中殘留的污染物。含有 尼古丁化學反應後產生的亞硝胺等 11 種致癌 物,造成兒童認知能力的缺陷,增加嬰幼兒哮 喘機率以及中耳炎的風險,尤其對常在家中爬 來爬去的幼兒威脅最大。

電子煙的危害:

腦 部:大腦發育遲緩、智力損傷、注意

力不集中、腦霧。

眼 睛:視網膜異常。

肺部呼吸道:咳嗽、氣喘、胸痛、肺炎、電子

煙肺傷害。

耳 朵:中耳疾病、聽力受損。

心 臟 血 管:心跳加快、血壓上升、心血管

疾病風險、中風。
